Dear Friends and Members of FLC,

As we celebrate Advent, Christmas, and the New Year, I would like to share an excerpt from our Advent Christmas Devotional for this year.

As Advent begins Jeremiah 33:14-15 reads, "The days are surely coming, says the Lord, when I will fulfill the promise I made to the house of Israel and the house of Judah. In those days and at that time I will cause a righteous Branch to spring up for David; and he shall execute justice and righteousness in the land."

The reflection for this text talks about peace lilies and how they look beautiful when you buy them because of their beautiful bloom. What people don't realize is that plant nurseries use gibberellic acid to force the peace lilies to bloom. But their beauty fades.

"In difficult times and in ordinary times, we often wonder what God is up to and when God will bring much-needed

newness to the struggles we face. It is tempting to want instant solutions to the problems in our lives and our world. But solutions that bring a quick bloom never last.

God offers something more profound than artificial answers to our real needs: a fulfillment of God's promises that lasts, the strong branch of justice and righteousness, the flower of peace. This cannot be forced by chemicals or manipulation or false promises. This comes through God's careful and patient work in our lives and in the world."

Prayer: "O God, grant me patience to wait for all the good things you are doing through Christ Jesus in my life and in the world. Amen." Good news, great joy: Devotions For Advent & Christmas 2024-2025.
